The dam retains water from the Sterk River in the Mogalakwena River basin, near Mokopane town. The Doorndraai Dam is at GPS co-ordinates 24° 16'45.2"S 28° 46'35.6"E. From Mokopane town, travel south along the R101 towards Mookgophong. After approximately 17 km, turn right at the Sterkriver/Doorndraai Dam turn-off and continue in a westerly direction for approximately 17 km. Turn left onto the gravel access road towards Doorndraai Dam and proceed for approximately 5 km towards the Doorndraai Dam Nature Reserve. DIRECTIONS: The site is situated in the Mpumalanga Province, near Hazyview and Bushbuckridge, South Africa, at **GPS co-ordinates 24°53'05.9"S 31°05'02.5"E**.

From Hazyview, take the R40 north towards Bushbuckridge, then turn left onto the Injaka Dam access road. Continue along the local access road towards the dam wall area at GPS co-ordinates 24°53'05.9"S 31°05'02.5"E, which leads to the Injaka Dam facility.
