Compulsory Briefing Session

A Compulsory briefing session will be held at **10:00 am on Tuesday, 29 September 2026**, at the **THEMBELIHLE TECHNICAL SERVICES BOARDROOM** in **HOPETOWN** (GPS COORDINATE: S 29° 37' 40" S ; 24° 04' 55" E).

DOORS WILL BE CLOSED AT 10:00 am SHARP. Bidders who do not attend the compulsory briefing session will expose their tenders to rejection. Bidders who arrive late will not be allowed to participate in the tender process.

Tender Document and Submission Details

Fully completed documents must be placed in a sealed envelope and placed in the tender box in the Foyer at the Thembelihle Local Municipal offices, corner of Mark and Church Streets, Hopetown, not later than the time and date stipulated, or be mailed via courier to reach the Tender Box before the specified closing date and time. The envelopes must be clearly marked with the tender number, title, bidder's name and closing date and time of the tender as above.

The tenders will be evaluated on Functionality and the 80/20 Preference Points system as prescribed by the Revised Preferential Procurement Policy Framework of 2022. Telephonic, facsimile, email, and/or late bids will not be accepted. The tender box will be emptied just after 12:00 on the closing date; thereafter, all bids will be opened in public.

Bids must remain **valid for a period of ninety (90) days after the closing date** of the bid.

The tenders will be evaluated on a 2-Stage Process:

Stage 1: Functionality

The following Evaluation criteria will be applied.

NB: The bidder must comply with the minimum requirements in accordance with the Functionality Criteria table above and must obtain at least 70 points under the Points Allocation of the Functionality Criteria to qualify.

Only Bidders found responsive in Stage 1 will be further evaluated in Stage 2.

Stage 2: 80/20 Preference Points system as prescribed by the Revised Preferential Procurement Policy Framework of 2022.
